

Approval of Resolution Reciting the Fact of the General Election held on November 8, 2016 Declaring the Result and Such Other Matters as Provided by Law.

Background:


On June 21, 2016, City Council approved Resolutions No. 2016-13 and 2016-14, Requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Imperial to conduct a General Municipal Election of the City of Calexico for three councilmember seats and render specified services to the City relating to the conduct of the election and to consolidate such election with any State or Local Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016. Pursuant to the resolution, the Registrar of Voters of the County of Imperial will canvass the returns of the election and certify the election results to the City Council of the City of Calexico.

Discussion & Analysis:

This item is placed before the City Council to declare the election results of the November 8, 2016 General Municipal Election. The Council is required to adopt a resolution reciting the fact of the election and declaring the results and such other matters as provided by law. Thereafter The Honorable Poli Flores will administer the oath of office to each person elected. Final results certified by the County of Imperial will be presented to the City Council prior to the meeting.

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-35

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALEXICO CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2016 DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Calexico, California on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2016-14, adopted on the 21st day of June, 2016, Requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Imperial to-render specified services to the City relating to the conduct of a General Municipal Election and to consolidate such election with any State or Local Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016.

WHEREAS, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the elections and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, that pursuant to the provisions of Section 10403 of the Elections Code of the State of California, this City Council requested the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the County Election Department to conduct the election of the City of Calexico according to State law, on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, to submit the following to the voters:

THREE SEATS ON THE CITY COUNCIL (4 YEAR TERMS).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALEXICO, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City of Calexico, a statement of the result of the election, showing:

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALEXICO, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016 FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN CITY OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Calexico on Tuesday, November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, three seats on the City Council are up for election on the November 8, 2016 ballot; and

WHEREAS, the City Council intends to consolidate its General Municipal Election with any other State, County or City election scheduled for November 8, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALEXICO, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Calexico, California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing three Members of the City Council for the full term of four years.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10403 of the Elections Code of the State of California, this City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the County Election Department to conduct the election of the City of Calexico according to State law, on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, to submit the following to the voters:

Three seats on the City Council (4 year terms)

SECTION 3. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 4. That the County is authorized, instructed, and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 5. That polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, pursuant to Elections Code §10242, except as provided in Elections Code §14401.


SECTION 6. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form, and manner.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall publish notice of the November 8, 2016 election in at least one newspaper of general circulation not earlier than the 127th nor later than the 113th day before the date of the election pursuant to Elections Code §12101.

SECTION 8. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 9. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.



SECTION 2. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10403 of the Elections Code of the State of California, this City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the County Election Department to conduct a General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2016.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to the provisions of Sections 10403, 10411, and 10418 of the Elections Code, the City Council hereby requests that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Imperial order the consolidation of the election of the General Municipal Election with any other State, City or County election scheduled for Tuesday, November 8, 2016. The City Council further authorizes the Board of Supervisors of the County of Imperial to take the steps necessary to hold, conduct, and canvas the returns of the election in accordance with applicable provisions of the Elections Code.

SECTION 4. That the City of Calexico shall reimburse the County for election services performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.




