**THE LIBRARY, ARTS AND HISTORICAL BOARD MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON THE 7<sup>th</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER 2019, AT 6:00 PM, AT THE CITY HALL, FERNANDO "NENE" TORRES COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 608 HEBER AVENUE, CALEXICO, CALIFORNIA. THE DATE, HOUR AND PLACE DULY ESTABLISHED FOR HOLDING SUCH SAID MEETING.**

**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Chair Pacheco at 6:15 pm.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Board member Carrillo.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Motion was made by Board member Carrillo to approve the agenda, seconded by Board member Pacheco and passed unanimously; the agenda was approved as delivered.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS AND PUBLIC APPEARANCES**

Ms. Gerardo provided the Board with an inventory report of chairs and tables located at the Carmen Durazo Cultural Arts Center.

**BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS**

Board member Durazo requested information on pricing for quality chairs to be added to the center's inventory. Ms. Gerardo will find this information. Board member Durazo recommended that instead of depositing the center's rental monies into the general fund, to use that money to replenish tables and chairs. 25 people were present at the California Arts Council workshop and those present were very interested in helping the City get grants. Board member Durazo thanked Eduardo Quintero for the set-up and Norma Gerardo for hosting it. Board member Durazo also mentioned that Gordy de Necochea would like the City to have a library administrative board as it was set up in the past.

Mr. Dale informed the Board that the Carmen Durazo Cultural Arts Center has a budget of \$12,000 which is a combination of \$6,000 from the City Manager's office and \$6,000 from the Recreation budget. The air conditioners were replaced; the door was fixed and the carpet was cleaned. U.S. Customs and Border Patrol will be using it on Thursday and the Hotel De Anza will use it as well. Ms. Gerardo requested extra trash cans from Republic Services and were placed in the "kitchen" area. After discussing logistics of who should store away tables and chairs after events, it was decided that it should be done by City crew in order to keep it consistent and organized.

Board member Carrillo heard wonderful things about the Oktoberfest event held in the City. Board member Durazo was unable to find a parking space close by. She suggested having a handicap area or having a golf cart picking people up for next time.

Board member Durazo mentioned that Paint Nights are set for the first Friday of each month. This past month 7 people were in attendance. They painted a fall escape and everyone enjoyed it. Ms. Gerardo mentioned that there will be three ways to register for Paint Nights, via phone, email or an online link. Those interested in participating may pay at the finance window or at the day of the event at the center.

#### **DISCUSSION AND POTENTIAL ACTION ITEMS**

- A. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR MEETING ON OCTOBER 7, 2019** –Motion to approve the minutes was made by Board member Carrillo; seconded by Board member Durazo. Motion carried unanimously.
- B. **THINK PINK ART EXHIBIT** – The California Wellness Center is requesting to rent the Carmen Durazo Cultural Arts Center to hold a fashion show and exhibit this month, as a non-profit organization. Board member Carrillo recalled that the term "Think Pink" is a trademark and should not be used. No action was taken on this item.
- C. **KASEY SCOTT ART EXHIBIT** –The ribbon cutting will take place on October 19<sup>th</sup> at 11:30 am and the Calexico Arts Council will staff the art exhibit. Board member Carrillo will provide ribbon and scissors for the ribbon cutting. Board member Durazo asked the board to volunteer for the event as well. If an art piece is sold, the artist will get 80% and the city the remaining 20%. The Imperial Valley Press published a very nice article on this event. No action was taken on this item.
- D. **ZOPPE CIRCUS** – This Circus will be at the Grand Plaza from November 22 to December 11. Ms. Gerardo is contacting non-profits to help with the sale of tickets. The entry tickets are \$25 and \$45. Board member Pacheco asked if there was a family package since it is quite expensive for our residents. No action was taken on this item.



Dear Ms. Tauler:

We're happy to provide funds for the fiscal year that began July 1, 2019 to support your California Library Literacy Services program and the important work you, your staff and volunteers do in your community.

The recently signed state budget continues California Library Literacy Services funding at \$4.82 million and \$2.5 million for family literacy.

At this time, we're providing the \$18,000 baseline amount for your program. The remainder will be sent in the fall after a review of the Final Report you submit to us in September.

There are three parts to the library's funding formula:

1. A *baseline* amount (\$18,000) for each approved literacy program to provide libraries with the funding needed to deliver a minimum level of local literacy staffing and services;
2. A *per capita* amount per adult learner served in the previous year; and
3. A *match* on local funds raised and expended for adult literacy services—reflecting a commitment to a continuing state/local partnership and providing an incentive for increased local support for adult literacy.
  - Your funds must be encumbered by June 30, 2020, and fully expended in accordance with your approved budget by December 31, 2020. Encumbered funds are those that have been deposited in the awardee's accounting system and for which a budget has been provided to and approved by the State Library.
  - Please refer to the new California Library Literacy Services allowable and unallowable costs document to guide your program expenditures and please get in touch with us if you have any questions.
  - We encourage you and your colleagues to participate in the library literacy training opportunities that will be made available by the State Library and regional networks.

The following specific issues or observations are being made about your application:

*We notice you report a decrease in adult learner numbers; they have decreased by more than 20% from last year's report. If you need assistance in developing strategies to increase and/or retain learners, please contact Natalie Cole at [natalie.cole@library.ca.gov](mailto:natalie.cole@library.ca.gov)*






