**THE LIBRARY, ARTS, AND HISTORICAL BOARD MET IN A REGULAR SESSION ON THE 5<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF MARCH 2018, AT 6:00 P.M., AT THE CITY HALL, FERNANDO "NENE" TORRES COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 605 HEBER AVENUE, CALEXICO, CALIFORNIA. THE DATE, HOUR AND PLACE DULY ESTABLISHED FOR HOLDING SUCH SAID MEETING.**

**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Chair Pacheco at 6:02 pm.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chair Pacheco.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Motion made by Board member Carrillo to approve agenda, seconded by Board member Durazo and passed unanimously; the agenda was approved as delivered.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS AND PUBLIC APPEARANCES**

None.

**BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS**

Before the board member comments, City Clerk Gabby Garcia swore in Board member Alvarado who was attending his first LAH board meeting. Board member Alvarado introduced himself and provided a brief summary of being a teacher for CUSD and his theater activities. Board member Durazo welcomed him. Chair Pacheco also welcomed Board Member Alvarado. Board Member Carrillo also extended her welcome.

No further board members comments.

**DISCUSSION AND POTENTIAL ACTION ITEMS**

- A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR MEETING ON FEBRUARY 5, 2018 – Motion to approve the minutes was made by Board member Carrillo; seconded by Board member Durazo, with the correction of minutes indicated and noted by Ms. Gomez. Revised motion made Board member Carrillo and seconded by Board member Durazo with noted correction to minutes. Motion carried unanimously.
- B. THE MURAL PROJECT – Community Services Director Sandra Tauler advised the board members of the new mural project cycle, Cycle 6, that had just opened up. Director Tauler advised that the Imperial Valley press had ran a very extensive article the on the mural project during the week, along with extensive coverage on FaceBook and in social media postings. Director Tauler advised that the artists have 6 months to complete the mural. Director Tauler explained that there is purposely no theme for the project. This is done to allow each artist to fully express their ideas, without limiting them with a specific theme. If they choose to have a theme, i.e. the City's upcoming 110th anniversary, they may do so; they would have to submit their

proposal outlining the theme. Motion was made to approve a stipend for the artist(s) of \$1,000, \$500 to start for materials and supplies, and \$500 at the completion of the project. Motion was made by Board member Carrillo and seconded by Chair Pacheco voted in favor. Motion carried unanimously.

- C. BORDER MURAL ART DISPLAYS – Update and approval of funding – City Manager David Dale presented to the three (3) locations that were being considered to place the first mural panels at Rockwood Plaza Park; location 1 would be at the area of 7<sup>th</sup> Street, near the Veterans memorial; location 2 would be between Heber and Mary, where the old Rockwood Plaza restrooms used to be located; location 3 would be on 5<sup>th</sup> and Heber, near Camp Salvation monument. City Manager Dale further advised that the funding for the restoration and installation needed to be increased, but not to exceed \$15,000. Board members discussed various sites for the installation of the panels at Rockwood Plaza. Board Member Durazo suggested that adjacent to the Veterans memorial would be a good idea. City Manager Dale agreed on this location too since electricity and other foundation requirements were already located there (i.e. electrical & water). Chair Pacheco commented that she thought that SDSU would be a good location to place the panels. Vice-Chair Cuevas stated that he thought that the Camp Salvation location would be more adequate since the location of that monument (Camp Salvation) reflected exactly what the border fence represented. Motion was made by Board Member Carrillo to approve the increase in funding for the restoration and installation of the border mural panels to \$15,000, (not to exceed this amount) and to increase the \$1,000 artist stipend to \$2,000 from \$1,000. This motion was seconded by Chair Pacheco. Motion carried unanimously.

#### INFORMATION

- D. FORM 700 – 2018 – Recording Secretary Gomez provided the LAH board members with their 2018 700 forms. Board members completed the 2018 forms and returned forms to Ms. Gomez. Ms. Gomez also had Board Members Carrillo and Durazo, and Chair Pacheco correct their 2017 700 forms.
- E. CML MONTHLY REPORT – JANUARY 2018 – Director Tauler briefly went over the CML activity report.
- F. JANUARY 2018 NEW BOOK LIST – Director Tauler provided the January 2018 new book list.
- G. WOMEN IN THE ARTS EXHIBIT AND CHAMBER MIXER – Director Tauler advised the present board members of the upcoming Women in the Arts Exhibit and Calexico Chamber of Commerce Mixer scheduled for March 6<sup>th</sup>. Director Tauler advised that the exhibit had like 50-60 art pieces. Flyer for event was attached on agenda back-up. Director Tauler encouraged all LAH board members to attend the event.
- H. CML MARCH 2018 & CD CAC MARCH 2018 CALENDAR – Director Tauler advised that the library's and cultural arts center calendars for March 2018 were included in the agenda..
- I. BI-NATIONAL CONCERT – Director Tauler advised that she had no information for this event other than that the Calexico High School band might be participating in this concert, along with their counterparts on the Mexican side. Board Member Durazo advised that Mayor Hurtado has been communicating with her on this event, along with Carmen Espinoza from Mexicali. Per Board Member Durazo, information has been put out there but nothing is concrete. Board Member Durazo advised that Mayor Hurtado is the one coordinating the event with Ms. Espinoza.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Before adjourning the meeting, Chair Pacheco inquired if the LAH board would be meeting on April 2, 2018 for the regularly scheduled meeting. Ms. Gomez advised that the day was a regular meeting date, but if she was not available, the LAH board could have a Special Meeting the following Monday, April 9, 2018. After some discussion, all LAH board members agreed to have a Special Meeting on April 9<sup>th</sup>.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Board member Carrillo and seconded by Chair Pacheco, and passed unanimously. Meeting was adjourned at 6:51 p.m.
