THE LIBRARY, ARTS AND HISTORICAL BOARD MET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON THE 3rd DAY OF JUNE 2019, AT 6:00 PM, AT THE CITY HALL, FERNANDO "NENE" TORRES COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 608 HEBER AVENUE, CALEXICO, CALIFORNIA. THE DATE, HOUR AND PLACE DULY ESTABLISHED FOR HOLDING SUCH SAID MEETING.

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Board member Carrillo at 6:00 pm.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Board member Durazo.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Board member Durazo announced that the Calexico Arts Council will be sponsoring an "ART AND HISTORY" class at the cultural arts center this summer. There will be two sessions:

Ages 8-12	Tuesday & Thursday	4:00 – 5:30 pm
Ages 13 and older	Tuesday & Thursday	4:00 – 5:30 pm

The classes will be offered free of charge to the students. There will be up to 20 participants in each session. A different historical building will be discussed and drawn every week. The class will have a guest speaker each week, who will provide information about the history of each building. Two of the presenters are Gabby Garcia, who will present the history of city hall, and Ms. Tauler, who will present the history of the Carnegie Library.

Board member Durazo also inquired about the status of the mural panels that are stored at the city shop. She asked that a letter be sent to the following people to confirm if they were still interested in the panel that was being held for them. They are: Dean Gregorio Ponce, SDSU, IV; Cesar Casillas, Gran Plaza; Hildy Carrillo, Calexico Chamber; Eddie Shiffer, CHS. Ms. Tauler will be sending out the letter and giving them a 30 day window to confirm their interest.

If the interest is not confirmed, there are other people/entities that have expressed an interest in getting one of the panels. They include Armando Rascon, for the Smithsonian Institute, and Israel Garcia Garcia for an art installation called Border Crossings that will be located in Kansas City.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion was made by Board member Durazo to approve the agenda, seconded by Board member Alvarado and passed unanimously; the agenda was approved with the addition of Item F1- recommended by City Manager Dale for adding lighting to the Border Mural.

DISCUSSION AND POTENTIAL ACTION ITEMS:

A. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES FOR MAY 6, 2019 MEETING

On motion by Board member Durazo, seconded by Board member Alvarado, and passed unanimously, the minutes were approved as delivered.

B. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES FOR MAY 21, 2019 MEETING

On motion by Board member Alvarado, seconded by Board member Acevedo, and passed unanimously, the minutes were approved as delivered.

C. APPROVAL OF DISTINGUISHED ARTIST APPLICATION FOR ROBERTO R. POZOS

The application for including Mr. Roberto R. Pozos into the Distinguished Artists Wall was submitted by Calexico Wellness Center. Mr. Pozos is a Calexico native, who graduated from Calexico High School in 1979. On motion by Board member Durazo, seconded by Board member Acevedo, and passed unanimously the application was approved. The Leaf Unveiling presentation will take place on June 4th at 6:00 pm. The exhibit will run from June 3 – 7, with a Paint and Wine class on Thursday night, and a closing reception on Friday night. Ms. Tauler will continue to advertise and will have everything ready for the unveiling.

D. LAH BOARD TO GO DARK FOR THE MONTHES OF JULY AND AUGUST 2019

Ms. Tauler explained that the summer was the busiest season for the department and it was also a time when some board members take vacation, so traditionally the Board goes dark for the summer. Board member Durazo expressed that she was against going dark during the busiest time of the year. She said it would be the first time the cultural arts center would have a separate budget and the board should advocate/lobby with the City Council members. After some discussion, a motion was made by Board member Carrillo, seconded by Board member Alvarado to have the Board go dark for the months of July and August. The motion carried 3 to one, with Board member Durazo voting against the motion.

E. INCREASE STIPEND FOR BORDER MURAL TO \$2,000 DUE TO THE SIZE OF WALL

Ms. Tauler explained to the Board that the customary stipend for each mural, under the Mural Project, was \$1,000. However, the mural that is being installed at the corner of Cesar Chavez and 2nd Street is located on an extremely large wall. Ms. Tauler recommended that the stipend for this mural be increased to \$2,000. On motion by Board member Durazo, seconded by Board member Acevedo, the recommendation was approved.

E1. APPROVAL OF LIGHTING FIXTURE AT BORDER MURAL USING ART IN PUBLIC PLACES FUNDS

City Manager Dale presented price quote from Supreme Electrical Contracting for the installation of a light pole with two spot lights and four lights on top of the wall to light the new border mural. The cost will be approximately \$16,000. There was discussion about the need for this lighting, as the mural is located at the very entrance of the Calexico from Mexico, so the lights will allow it to be seen at night. On motion by Board member Durazo, seconded by Board member Alvarado, and passed unanimously, the funding request for this installation was approved.
