**THE LIBRARY, ARTS AND HISTORICAL BOARD MET IN A REGULAR SESSION ON THE 2<sup>ND</sup> DAY OF JULY 2018, AT 6:00 PM, AT THE CITY HALL, FERNANDO "NENE" TORRES COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 608 HEBER AVENUE, CALEXICO, CALIFORNIA. THE DATE, HOUR AND PLACE DULY ESTABLISHED FOR HOLDING SUCH SAID MEETING.**

**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Chair Pacheco at 6:05 pm.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chair Pacheco.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Motion was made by Board member Durazo to approve the agenda, seconded by Board member Cuevas and passed unanimously; the agenda was approved as delivered.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS AND PUBLIC APPEARANCES**

**DISCUSSION AND POTENTIAL ACTION ITEMS**

- A. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR MEETING ON APRIL 9, 2018** –Motion to approve the minutes was made by Board member Alvarado; seconded by Board member Cuevas. Motion carried unanimously.
- B. **CLEAN-UP AND RESTORATION OF MURALS AT NOSOTROS PARK** – Ms. Legaspi informed the board that the murals have been damaged greatly. The artist agreed to restore it for a \$500 fee. Board member Durazo moved to approve the item, and it was seconded by Board member Cuevas. Motion carried unanimously.

- C. **APPROVAL OF CYCLE 6 APPLICATION FOR ROBERT ROMERO** –Board member Cuevas motioned to approve the application from Robert Romero; Board member Durazo seconded, and opened it up for discussion. Mrs. Durazo questioned who had approved cycle 6. Board member Alvarado mentioned that they had voted via email and that Ms. Tauler had provided pictures of the submissions. Motion carried unanimously.
- D. **MURAL PROJECT FOR CARNEGIE LIBRARY** – Ms. Legaspi explained to the board that a mural proposal from Guanajuato was received to commemorate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of Andrew Carnegie. If approved, they would send the artist and pay for all costs. The board would have the ultimate decision of the size and placement of the mural. Board member Durazo mentioned that she remembers that there are some guidelines that need to be followed for historical buildings and would like them to be revised before committing to placing a mural, but she liked the idea. Chair Pacheco would rather not place any murals in a historical building. Vice-Chair Cuevas moved to table this item until guidelines are reviewed, seconded by Chair Pacheco. Motion to table item carried unanimously.

#### **INFORMATION**

- E. **CML MONTHLY REPORT – MARCH, APRIL & MAY 2018** – This report was provided as an informational item. Vice-Chair Cuevas mentioned that he sees low patronage at the library. He sees more people visiting the Yuma and the El Centro Public Libraries. Board member Durazo mentioned that her daughter and granddaughter visited from Oakland and they were able to participate in some of the summer programs at the library. Both were impressed by the services provided and all the educational toys provided to the community. She also mentioned that she was glad to see so many organizations helped fund this summer’s program and the willingness of the library to allow students to volunteer and gain experience while at the library. Mr. Cuevas inquired about how much Measure H funding goes to the summer program. Chair Pacheco asked how does the library inform the public of its activities. Ms. Legaspi mentioned that every day the Imperial Valley Press, in their upcoming events section, features the daily activities to be held at the library, in addition, word-of-mouth, Facebook and emails are mediums used to advertise and promote library programs.
- F. **NEW BOOK LIST – MARCH, APRIL & MAY 2018** – Chair Pacheco would like to have just one agenda packet printed for all board members to share thus saving paper and ink. Vice-Chair Cuevas said that he likes getting the agenda packet. Board member Durazo mentioned that this is a management decision, but at the same time, they are to share information in the packet with City Council and/or constituents since they are a City Commission. Mrs. Durazo inquired about the July calendar for the Carmen Durazo Cultural Arts Center. Ms. Legaspi informed her that there are not many activities happening there during the summer
- G. **SUMMER PROGRAM CALENDAR** – The Camarena Memorial Library’s summer calendar was provided as an informational item.

**H. UPDATE ON MURAL PROJECT** – Board member Durazo informed the board that the mural project is being slowly built. She mentioned that the inauguration of the mural should be postponed to a later date. A garden will be placed surrounded by a brick wall. Once that is complete, the artists, Eduardo Kintero and Luis Hernandez will be able to start working on it.

Dear Ms. Tauler:

We're happy to provide funds for the fiscal year that began July 1, 2018 to support your California Library Literacy Services program and the important work you, your staff and volunteers do in your community.

The recently signed state budget continues California Library Literacy Services funding at \$4.82 million and adds \$2.5 million for family literacy.

At this time, we're providing the \$18,000 baseline amount for your program. The remainder will be sent in the fall after a review of the Final Report you submit to us in September.

There are three parts to the library's funding formula:

1. A *baseline* amount (\$18,000) for each approved literacy program to provide libraries with the funding needed to deliver a minimum level of local literacy staffing and services;
2. A *per capita* amount per adult learner served in the previous year; and
3. A *match* on local funds raised and expended for adult literacy services—reflecting a commitment to a continuing state/local partnership and providing an incentive for increased local support for adult literacy.

The payment process begins once we receive your signed Claim Form (attached). Please direct any questions to: Andrea Freeland @ 916.651.3191 and/or [andrea.freeland@library.ca.gov](mailto:andrea.freeland@library.ca.gov).

**NOTE:** All claims must be completed and signed in both places and all claims must be mailed to Fiscal Office – must have original signatures to process claims.
