SUBJECT: Authorize City Manager to Issue Purchase Order to Red One Electric, Inc. in the Amount of \$62,276.00 for Electrical Services in Order to Connect Three (3) Mobile Clarifiers During the Rehabilitation of Clarifier "B" and "C" Project at Water Treatment Plant.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council of the City of Calexico approve the following:

1. Authorize City Manager to issue Purchase Order to Red One Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$62,276.00 for Electrical Services in order to connect three (3) mobile clarifiers during the rehabilitation of Clarifier "B" and "C" Project at Water Treatment Plant.

Background:

On June 4, 2025, the City Council of the City of Calexico authorized the Interim City Manager to sign Master Services Agreement with Utility Services Co., Inc. for the Rehabilitation of Clarifier "B" and "C" at the Water Treatment Plant.

Clarifiers are integral to both drinking water treatment facilities and wastewater treatment plants. Clarifiers play a vital role in maintaining public health by effectively removing pathogens and pollutants from raw water sources. Clarifiers suspend solids and turbidity, clarifiers facilitate the action of downstream treatment processes such as filtration and disinfection, ensuring compliance with stringent water quality regulations.

The City of Calexico Water Treatment Plant currently has two (2) clarifiers:

- Clarifier "B"

- 4.2 Million Gallons per Day (MGD)
- 55-foot diameter clarifier
- Built in 1968
- Clarifier "C"
 - 10.0 Million Gallon per Day (MGD)
 - 80-foot diameter clarifier.
 - Built in 1998 and rebuild in 2010 due to April 4, 2010 earthquake

On September 3, 2025, the City Council of the City of Calexico authorized the City Manager to issue purchase order to Veolia WTS Services USA, Inc. in the amount of \$603,235.00 for the rental of three (3) mobile clarifiers during the Rehabilitation of Clarifier "B" and "C" Project at Water Treatment Plant.

Discussion and Analysis:

On December 4, 2025, Utility Services Co., Inc. began rehabilitating Clarifier "B." It is estimated that Clarifier "B" will be in service by January 30, 2026. In order for Utility Services Co., Inc. to begin working on Clarifier "C" the City needs to install three (3) mobile clarifiers. The mobile clarifiers will assist the City in maintaining water capacity and meet State requirements. The mobile clarifiers require specialized electrical wiring, connection and disconnection.

Due to the limited time frame of installation, Public Works staff requested price quotes from local vendors for electrical services. The Public Works Department received two (2) proposals from the following vendors:

Vendor	Amount
Premier Electrical Solutions, Inc.	\$52,400.00
Red One Electric, Inc.	\$62,276.00

After carefully reviewing the proposals, Public Works staff is recommending that the City Council of the City of Calexico authorize the City Manager to issue purchase order to Red One Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$62,276.00 for electrical services because Premier Electrical Solutions, Inc. missed to include an important component which is the connection from trailer to disconnect breaker inside the building.
