

Recommendation:


Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Calexico authorizing the acceptance from Caltrans of Relinquished Right-of-Way, and authorizing the execution of all other necessary and appropriate documents related to the Relinquishment, for portion of Cesar Chavez Boulevard and Estrada Boulevard.

Background:

The State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with the City of Calexico, proposes to improve traffic operations, enhance bicycle and pedestrian access, and improve drainage performance on State Route (SR) 98. SR-98 between V.V. Williams Avenue and Ollie Avenue was widened from two to four lanes. Caltrans is proposing to widen SR-98 from Ollie Avenue through HWY 111 from four to six lanes in 2020.

Discussion & Analysis:

Caltrans has completed the construction of SR-98 West Widening Phase 1B Project and are requesting to relinquish to the City of Calexico portion of Cesar Chavez Boulevard (Segment 1) and Estrada Boulevard (Segment 2) that they acquired due to said project. Public Works staff is requesting that the City Council of the City of Calexico adopt the attached resolution in order to authorize the following:



1. Authorize the City Manager and/or his designee(s) to accept the relinquishment of certain Caltrans' right-of-way shown as "SEGMENT 1" (Cesar Chavez Blvd.) and "SEGMENT 2" (Estrada Blvd.) on the attached Exhibit A.
2. Authorize the City Manager and/or his designee(s) to execute any and all documents that are necessary and appropriate to effectuate the above City Council authorized acceptance of the Caltrans right-of-way.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALEXICO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE FROM CALTRANS OF RELINQUISHMENT RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ALL OTHER NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THE RELINQUISHMENT, FOR CESAR CHAVEZ BOULEVARD AND ESTRADA BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, the City of Calexico, in coordination with State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the Federal Highway Administration, proposed improvements to portions of State Route (SR) 98 between V.V. Williams Avenue to Ollie Avenue; and

WHEREAS, said portion of Cesar Chavez Boulevard ("SEGMENT 1") and Estrada Boulevard ("SEGMENT 2"), were acquired by Caltrans for SR-98 West Widening Phase 1B Project, which widen SR-98 from two lanes to four lanes from V.V. Williams Avenue to Ollie Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans has completed SR-98 West Widening Phase 1B Project and is now requesting to relinquish to the City of Calexico "SEGMENT 1" and "SEGMENT 2"; and

WHEREAS, said right-of-way shown as "SEGMENT 1" and "SEGMENT 2", as presented in Exhibit A, has been reviewed and examined by the City Council of the City of Calexico.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Calexico that it does hereby approve the following:

1. Authorize the City Manager and/or his designee(s) to accept the relinquishment of certain Caltrans' right-of-way shown as "SEGMENT 1" and "SEGMENT 2" on the attached Exhibit A.
2. Authorize the City Manager and/or his designee(s) to execute any and all documents that are necessary and appropriate to effectuate the above City Council authorized acceptance of the Caltrans right-of-way.





