RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Endorsement and Support of the Community Public Safety Meeting, hosted by the Calexico Police Advisory Commission in partnership with the Calexico Women’s Improvement Club, and authorize the use and distribution of the event flyer for public outreach and community engagement purposes.

BACKGROUND

The Calexico Police Advisory Commission has organized a Community Public Safety Meeting intended to provide residents, business owners, community stakeholders, and local agencies with an opportunity to discuss current public safety concerns affecting the City of Calexico. The flyer announces a three-hour public meeting scheduled for Thursday, June 11, at the Calexico Women’s Improvement Club, and identifies the event as open and free to the public.

The meeting is intended to provide a public forum to discuss issues such as graffiti, vandalism, traffic concerns, code enforcement, neighborhood quality-of-life issues, and other matters impacting residents and businesses. The meeting will have participation from community leaders and public safety representatives, including the Calexico Police Chief, Imperial County District Attorney, Chief Probation Officer, Calexico City Mayor, Calexico Unified School District representatives, and other community partners.

DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

Public safety is a shared responsibility that requires communication, collaboration, and trust between the City, law enforcement, local agencies, schools, community organizations, and residents. The Community Public Safety Meeting provides an important opportunity for the public to express concerns, receive information, and participate in meaningful dialogue regarding issues affecting neighborhoods, schools, businesses, and public spaces throughout Calexico.

Endorsing this event supports the City’s ongoing commitment to transparency, community policing, crime prevention, code enforcement coordination, and quality-of-life improvements. The meeting also allows residents to hear directly from public safety leaders and partner agencies regarding available resources, current challenges, and collaborative efforts to address community concerns.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no significant fiscal impact associated with the City’s endorsement of the Community Public Safety Meeting or the distribution of the flyer. Any minor costs related to printing, outreach, facility coordination, or event support may be absorbed through available departmental resources, donations, or community partner support, as applicable.
