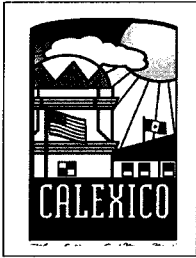

SUBJECT: Approval of a Resolution City Council of the City of Calexico Declaring its Intent to Accept Relinquishment of SR 111 between Second Street and State Route 98 from the California Department of Transportation

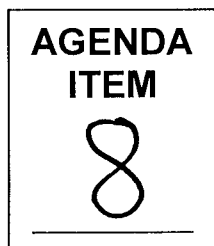
Staff requests that the City Council approve attached Resolution No. _____:

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Calexico Authorizing the City Manager and City Clerk to accept Relinquishment of SR 111 between Second Street and State Route 98 as depicted on Relinquishment Map No R34636 from the State of California Department of Transportation and authorize the City Manager to accept and execute any Certificates of Acceptance, Relinquishments, Grant Deeds and any other documents as may be necessary to full execute the relinquishment and to take any other actions that may be necessary in furtherance of the relinquishment.

Background:

The California Department of Transportation ("Caltrans") has offered to relinquish a portion of SR 111 between Second Street and State Route 98 ("SR-98"), as shown in the attached relinquishment map as Relinquishment No. R34636. The City has reviewed this relinquishment map and has decided to accept said relinquishment to facilitate the new Port of Entry project.

California Streets and Highways Code section 73 describes the process for collecting such relinquishments and requires the City to take possession of such property by a Resolution. The certified copy of the resolution shall be filed with the City Clerk and then a certified copy of the resolution needs to be recorded at the Imperial County Recorder's Office.



There are a number of improvements that are being completed by Caltrans along SR 111 relating to street lights and other improvements. The acceptance of relinquishment will not affect these improvements or require the City to accept financial responsibility for their completion.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALEXICO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY CLERK TO ACCEPT RELINQUISHMENT OF SR 111 BETWEEN SECOND STREET AND STATE ROUTE 98 AS DEPICTED ON RELINQUISHMENT MAP NO R34636 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND EXECUTE ANY CERTIFICATES OF ACCEPTANCE, RELINQUISHMENTS, GRANT DEEDS AND ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO FULL EXECUTE THE RELINQUISHMENT AND TO TAKE ANY OTHER ACTIONS THAT MAY BE NECESSARY IN FURTHERANCE OF THE RELINQUISHMENT

The City Council of the City of Calexico does resolve as follows:

SECTION 1: The City Council finds and declares as follows:

- A. The State of California Department of Transportation (“Caltrans”) is authorized to relinquish certain areas of right of way pursuant to Streets and Highways Code section 73 within a local agency’s jurisdiction, with the local agency’s consent, and with the approval of the California Transportation Commission (“CTC”);
- B. Caltrans intends to relinquish property within the City’s jurisdiction (the “Relinquished Property”). The Relinquished Property is depicted on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference;
- C. Caltrans intends to offer the Relinquished Property to the City at no charge, subject to the CTC’s approval;
- D. The City of Calexico is willing to accept the Relinquished Property from Caltrans upon approval by the California Transportation Commission (CTC) of a Resolution of Relinquishment and Caltrans’ recording of said Resolution in the County Recorder’s Office.

SECTION 2: Request for Relinquishment. The City of Calexico desires to accept the Relinquished Property upon approval by the CTC of a Resolution of Relinquishment and Caltrans’ recording of said Resolution in the County Recorder’s Office.

SECTION 3: Waiver. The City Council of the City of Calexico hereby waives the 90-day notice of intention to relinquish pursuant to Streets and Highways Code section 73.

SECTION 4: Authorization. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take all steps needed to accept the relinquishment, including, without limitation, accepting and executing any certificates of acceptance, relinquishments, grant deeds, any other

documents, and any other actions as may be necessary in furtherance of the relinquishment.

SECTION 4: Environmental Assessment. This activity is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061 (b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the relinquishment in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

SECTION 5: The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.

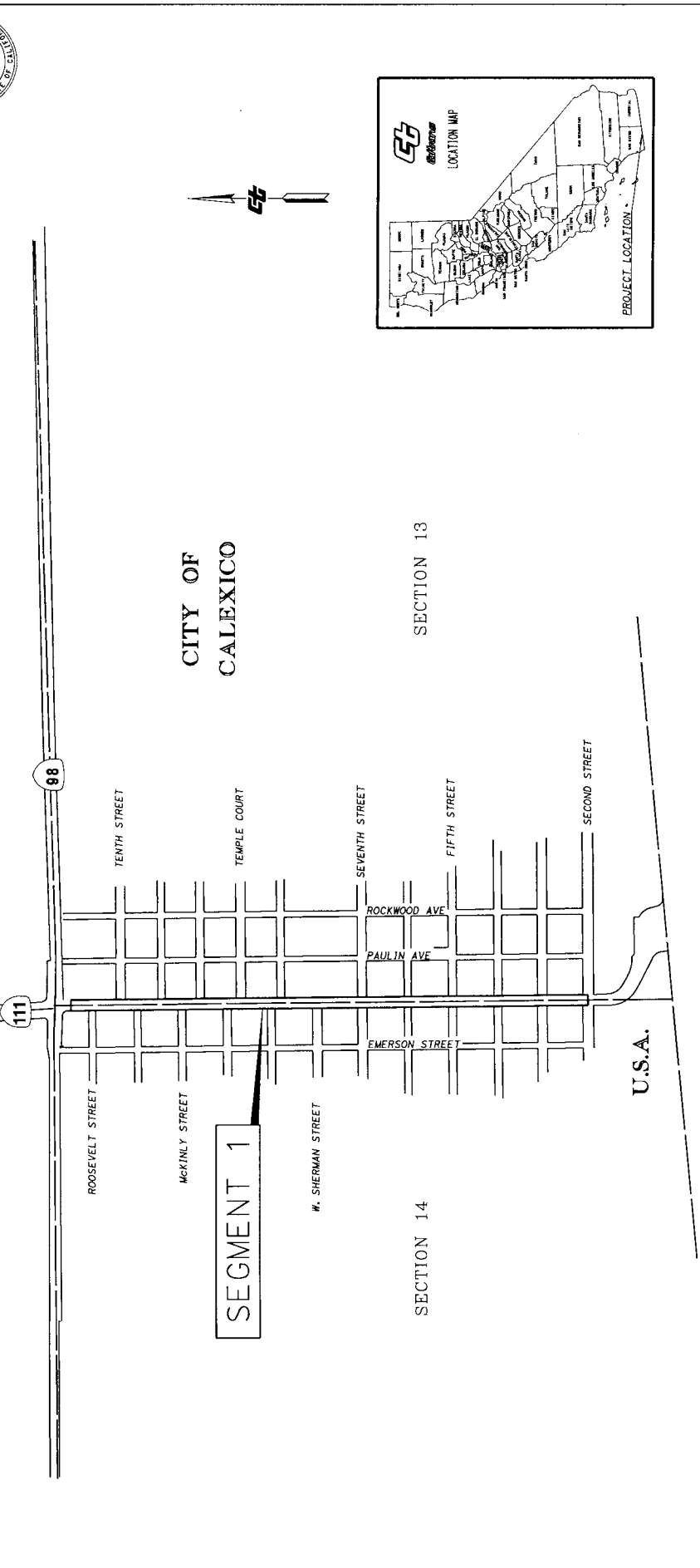
STATE HIGHWAY MAP NO. 1

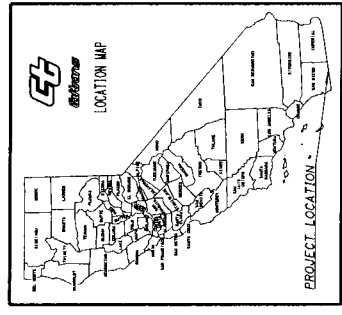
