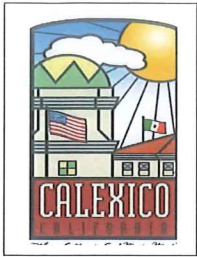

This event has grown to serving over 4,000 farm workers a full breakfast of tamales, beans, sweet bread and coffee and gifts.
