**SUBJECT:** Adopt Resolution No. 2024-82 Certifying the Results of the General Municipal Election Held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

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**Recommendation:**

Adopt Resolution No. 2024-82 Certifying the Results of the General Municipal Election Held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

**Background:**

On June 12, 2024, City Council approved Resolution No. 2022-42, Requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Imperial to conduct a General Municipal Election of the City of Calexico for:

- Three Council Member Seats (Four Year Term)
- Two Council Member Seats (Two Year Term)

and render specified services to the City relating to the conduct of the election and to consolidate such election with and State or Local Election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. Pursuant to the resolution, the Registrar of Voters of the County of Imperial will canvass the returns to the election and certify the election results to the City Council of the City of Calexico.

**Discussion and Analysis:**

A General Municipal Election was held in the City of Calexico on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, consolidated with the Statewide General Election for the purposes of election of City Council Members. The County of Imperial Registrar of Voters has completed the canvass of the results, and the appropriate Resolution has been prepared for adoption, which is attached to this Report. The results are attached as Exhibit "A" to the above-entitled Resolution.

As a result of the election, the following candidates were elected:

- Victor Legaspi for City Council for a full term of four years.
- Adriana Marquez for City Council for a full term of four years.

Lorenzo "Lencho" Calderon for City Council for a full term of four years.  
Diana Nuricumbo for City Council for a partial term of two years.  
Lisa Nichole Tylenda for City Council for a partial term of two years.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-82**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALEXICO RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024; DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.**

**WHEREAS**, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Calexico, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, as required by law; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the election was given in the time, form and manner as provided by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed, and in all respects the elections were held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in the time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Election Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council; the results are received, attached, and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Calexico hereby finds, determines and resolves as follows:

**Section 1.** That the whole number of ballots cast in the precincts including vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots are detailed in the Official Canvass attached as Exhibit A.

**Section 2.** That the names of the persons voted for in the election for Member of City Council were as follows:

Full Term – Four Year

1. Victor Legaspi
2. Adriana Marquez
3. Lorenzo "Lencho" Calderon
4. Gilberto Manzanarez
5. Joong S. Kim
6. Camilo Garcia
7. Raul Urefia
8. Javier Moreno

Partial Term – Two Year

1. Diana Nuricumbo
2. Lisa Nichole Tylenda
3. Lee Sepulveda
4. Morris Reisin

**Section 3.** That the number of votes cast in each precinct, and the number of votes cast in the City for each of the persons above-named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates are set forth in "Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 4.** The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election:

- 1) Victor Legaspi, Adriana Marquez and Lorenzo "Lencho" Calderon were elected as Members of the City Council for the full term of four years.
- 2) Diana Nuricumbo and Lisa Nichole Tylenda were elected as Members of the City Council for the partial term of two years.

**Section 5.** The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City of Calexico, a statement of result of the election, showing:

- 1) The whole number of votes/ballots cast in the City
- 2) The names of the persons voted for
- 3) For what office each person was voted
- 4) The number of votes cast at each precinct for each person
- 5) The total number of votes cast for each person

**Section 6.** The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

**Section 7.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

**Section 8.** Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, or clause or phrase in this Resolution or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Resolution or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted each section irrespective of the fact that any one or more subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, or phrases are declared unconstitutional, invalid, or ineffective.

**Section 9.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
