



WHAT IS CERT?

A Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) is a ready group of organized & trained volunteers that operate during a disaster at the neighborhood level.

CERT educates individuals about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their home, neighborhood, or workplace and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations.

- Emergency Preparedness
- Fire Safety
- Emergency Medical Operations (Triage, Wound Care)
- Light search and Rescue
- Disaster Psychology
- Terrorism
- Disaster Simulation
