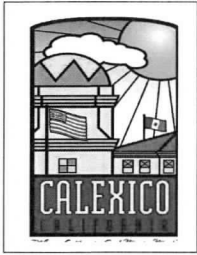

Recommendation:

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Calexico Supporting Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Funding, Project Milestone Dates, and Timely Use of Funds.

Background:

On November 18, 2021, the Imperial County Transportation Commission (ICTC) called out for project under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) for Fiscal Year 2022/2023, 2023/2024, and 2024/2025. All Imperial Valley agencies were instructed to submit project listings based on the locally adopted criteria by ICTC Technical Advisory Committee. The adopted criteria are as follows:

- Must be a transportation project
- Generate an emissions reduction
- Located in or benefit a nonattainment or maintenance area

The ICTC Technical Advisory Committee will evaluate the projects submitted, rank them and submit their recommendation to ICTC for final adoption and CMAQ programming.

On March 2, 2022, the City Council of the City of Calexico adopted Resolution No. 2022-16 Supporting Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Funding, Project Milestone Dates, and Timely Use of Funds for the following project:

- Sidewalk Improvement Project
The City of Calexico is proposing to install sidewalk and American with Disabilities Act (ADA) complaint handicap ramps at the following locations:



1. Grant Street between Pierce Avenue and Emilia Drive
2. Calexico Street between Adler Avenue to Kloke Avenue
3. Van de Graaf between Cole Boulevard and Calexico 10 Theaters.

Discussion & Analysis:

On March 17, 2022, members of ICTC Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) met to review, score and rank eleven (11) projects. ICTC TAC will be recommending to ICTC to fund the City of Calexico Sidewalk Improvement Project in the amount of \$265,000 (\$230,000 CMAQ and \$35,000 Local Match). Originally the City's local match was \$30,396 but now it will be \$35,000. For this reason, Public Works staff is requesting that the City Council adopt a revised a resolution of the City Council of the City of Calexico Supporting Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Funding, Project Milestone Dates, and Timely Use of Funds with the correct local match.






