

**Recommendation:**

Approve the Qualified Applicant for the Sale of Safe and Sane Fireworks for 2017:

- Ministerio en Accion Mas Que Vencedores
- Christ Community Church of Imperial Valley

**Discussion & Analysis:**

The City of Calexico accepted applications for permits to sell Safe and Sane Fireworks. Permits are issued only to nonprofit organizations and such fireworks shall be sold only at an outdoor sales stands. Upon approval by the council the applicant will be notified of the granting or rejection of their application. This is all in accordance with Calexico Municipal Code Chapter 15.24.

Qualified nonprofit organizations were required to have been organized and established in the city's corporate limits for a minimum of one year prior to filing an application. A majority of the members have been residents of the City of Calexico. The nonprofit must conduct activities primarily for the benefit of the city and its residents, or must serve more residents than non-city residents to be eligible to receive a permit. Nonprofit organizations will not be granted more than one permit.

The above listed nonprofit groups submitted all the required application forms and fees and have been prequalified by the City Manager per Calexico Municipal Code Section 15.24-Fireworks, and recommended for approval by the Interim Fire Chief. The City Council shall, in its sole discretion determine the nonprofit organization to which permits will be granted in accordance with Chapter 15.24 of the Calexico Municipal Code. Such determination shall be made at a regular or special meeting of the City Council in accordance with procedures established by the City Council. Only nonprofit organizations

**AGREEMENT TO COMPLY  
With  
Calexico Fire Department  
REQUIREMENTS FOR FIREWORKS STANDS**

I, SAUL GARCIA, an authorized representative or officer of MINISTERIO EN ACCION MAS QUE VENCEDORES, a nonprofit organization, agrees to comply with the following requirements set forth herein:

- (a) No person shall fire, discharge, set off, or use any fireworks of any kind within the City. No parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care and custody of any minor child shall allow such child to violate the provisions of this section.
- (b) Notwithstanding the above, "safe and sane fireworks" may be discharged during the hours of 12:00 p.m. noon to 10:00 p.m. on June 28, and from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on June 29 through and including July 4, by adults or by minors under the direct supervision of an adult.
- (c) No person shall sell any fireworks in the City other than safe and sane fireworks, except during the hours of 12:00 p.m. noon to 10:00 p.m. on June 28, and from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on June 29 through and including July 4. No person shall sell fireworks within the City limits without having first obtained a permit from the City to do so, as provided in Chapter 15.24 of the Calexico Municipal Code, and then only upon the terms and conditions specified in the granting of such permit. No person less than 18 years of age may sell, purchase, possess, use, or discharge "safe and sane fireworks."
- (d) No holder of a permit shall sell or distribute any type of fireworks which fall within the State Fire Marshal's definition of a "flare" or "California candle."
- (e) All applicants, at the time of application, must have in their possession a valid "Retailers' License" issued by the State Fire Marshal.
- (f) After the permit application has been approved by the City Manager's Office, permits shall also be obtained from the City of Calexico Building Department or the installation of any electrical equipment required for such stands. For the purpose of this part, every premise or structure form which the fireworks are sold is hereby defined as a "fireworks stand."
- (g) No fireworks stand shall be located within 25 feet of another building, within 25 feet of a generator, within five feet of a curb line, nor within 100 feet of any gasoline pump.
- (h) All fireworks stands shall be pre-assembled metal stands only with no more than 256 square feet. All fireworks stands will be pre-wired for interior and exterior lighting. All stands will have attached metal floors to enhance security and waterproofing.
- (i) Every fireworks stand shall be equipped with signs bearing the words "No Smoking" in red lettering at least four inches in height. Such signs shall be visible to every person working in the stand and every customer while being served.
- (j) All electrical must be conduits. The breaker boxes will be GFI breakers. The manufacturer must have installed all wiring. Absolutely no wiring allowed at the stand site.
- (k) Each stand must have at least two exits, approximately equal distance apart, and in no case shall the distance between exits exceed twenty-four (24) feet.
- (l) There shall be no signs except for the signs that come with the pre-assembled stands.
- (m) Each stand shall be provided with two (2), two-and-one-half (2 1/2) gallon water pressure type fire extinguishers, underwriter approved, IN GOOD WORKING ORDER, and easily accessible for use in case of fire.

- (n) All weeds and combustible material shall be cleared from the location of the stand to a distance of at least 25 feet.
- (o) Each stand must have an adult in attendance and in charge thereof while fireworks are stored therein. Each stand must have security personnel at least 21 years of age on site during non-operating hours. Sleeping or remaining in the stand after close of each business day is forbidden.
- (p) All unsold stock and accompanying litter shall be removed from the location by 5:00 p.m. on July 5.
- (q) No fireworks stand shall be erected more than three (3) calendar days prior to the time on which fireworks may lawfully be sold. The fireworks stand shall be removed from the temporary location by 12:00 p.m. noon the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July and all accompanying litter shall be cleared from the location by said time and date.
- (r) For each day or portion thereof that a fireworks stand is erected, maintained, or left standing contrary to the provisions of these requirements, the permittee may be subject to an administrative citation.
- (s) The Chief of the Calexico Fire Department and/or his designated representative shall have the power to suspend or revoke the permit of any permittee who is operating a fireworks stand in violation of any state law, local ordinance, or these permit requirements, or which, in his opinion, constitutes or creates a condition contributing to the cause or spread of fire.
- (t) The decision of the Fire Chief or his designee to suspend the permit of any permittee shall be subject to review by the Administrative Hearing Officer, forthwith. In view of the limited sales period each year, for suspensions affecting such sale period, a hearing shall be held at the earliest possible time that the permittee, the Administrative Hearing Officer or his designee, and the Fire Chief or his representative can schedule a meeting for such review for suspensions after the sale period. The hearing shall be held within one month after the request for hearing, which request must be made within fifteen (15) days after notice of the suspension. The Administrative Hearing Officer or his designee is authorized to set aside the suspension, or to modify the suspension by limiting its effect to only one or more days, or by setting aside the forfeiture of priority status for future years. The decision of the Administrative Hearing Officer or his/her designee shall be final.
- (u) The Calexico Fire Department will conduct an operator safety seminar for those individuals staffing the fireworks stands. Once the stand is stocked with fireworks, a member of the organization who has attended the seminar must be present during the business hours.
- (v) The Calexico Fire Department shall inspect the stand prior to its opening to the public. Periodic inspections will be conducted to ensure the safe operation of the stand.



**AGREEMENT TO COMPLY  
With  
Calexico Fire Department  
REQUIREMENTS FOR FIREWORKS STANDS**

I, Frank Zazueta, an authorized representative or officer of CHRIST COMMUNITY CHURCH - CALEXICO, a nonprofit organization, agrees to comply with the following requirements set forth herein:

- (a) No person shall fire, discharge, set off, or use any fireworks of any kind within the City. No parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care and custody of any minor child shall allow such child to violate the provisions of this section.
- (b) Notwithstanding the above, "safe and sane fireworks" may be discharged during the hours of 12:00 p.m. noon to 10:00 p.m. on June 28, and from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on June 29 through and including July 4, by adults or by minors under the direct supervision of an adult.
- (c) No person shall sell any fireworks in the City other than safe and sane fireworks, except during the hours of 12:00 p.m. noon to 10:00 p.m. on June 28, and from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on June 29 through and including July 4. No person shall sell fireworks within the City limits without having first obtained a permit from the City to do so, as provided in Chapter 15.24 of the Calexico Municipal Code, and then only upon the terms and conditions specified in the granting of such permit. No person less than 18 years of age may sell, purchase, possess, use, or discharge "safe and sane fireworks."
- (d) No holder of a permit shall sell or distribute any type of fireworks which fall within the State Fire Marshal's definition of a "flare" or "California candle."
- (e) All applicants, at the time of application, must have in their possession a valid "Retailers' License" issued by the State Fire Marshal.
- (f) After the permit application has been approved by the City Manager's Office, permits shall also be obtained from the City of Calexico Building Department or the installation of any electrical equipment required for such stands. For the purpose of this part, every premise or structure form which the fireworks are sold is hereby defined as a "fireworks stand."
- (g) No fireworks stand shall be located within 25 feet of another building, within 25 feet of a generator, within five feet of a curb line, nor within 100 feet of any gasoline pump.
- (h) All fireworks stands shall be pre-assembled metal stands only with no more than 256 square feet. All fireworks stands will be pre-wired for interior and exterior lighting. All stands will have attached metal floors to enhance security and waterproofing.
- (i) Every fireworks stand shall be equipped with signs bearing the words "No Smoking" in red lettering at least four inches in height. Such signs shall be visible to every person working in the stand and every customer while being served.
- (j) All electrical must be conduits. The breaker boxes will be GFI breakers. The manufacturer must have installed all wiring. Absolutely no wiring allowed at the stand site.
- (k) Each stand must have at least two exits, approximately equal distance apart, and in no case shall the distance between exits exceed twenty-four (24) feet.
- (l) There shall be no signs except for the signs that come with the pre-assembled stands.
- (m) Each stand shall be provided with two (2), two-and-one-half (2 1/2) gallon water pressure type fire extinguishers, underwriter approved, IN GOOD WORKING ORDER, and easily accessible for use in case of fire.

- (n) All weeds and combustible material shall be cleared from the location of the stand to a distance of at least 25 feet.
- (o) Each stand must have an adult in attendance and in charge thereof while fireworks are stored therein. Each stand must have security personnel at least 21 years of age on site during non-operating hours. Sleeping or remaining in the stand after close of each business day is forbidden.
- (p) All unsold stock and accompanying litter shall be removed from the location by 5:00 p.m. on July 5.
- (q) No fireworks stand shall be erected more than three (3) calendar days prior to the time on which fireworks may lawfully be sold. The fireworks stand shall be removed from the temporary location by 12:00 p.m. noon the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July and all accompanying litter shall be cleared from the location by said time and date.
- (r) For each day or portion thereof that a fireworks stand is erected, maintained, or left standing contrary to the provisions of these requirements, the permittee may be subject to an administrative citation.
- (s) The Chief of the Calexico Fire Department and/or his designated representative shall have the power to suspend or revoke the permit of any permittee who is operating a fireworks stand in violation of any state law, local ordinance, or these permit requirements, or which, in his opinion, constitutes or creates a condition contributing to the cause or spread of fire.
- (t) The decision of the Fire Chief or his designee to suspend the permit of any permittee shall be subject to review by the Administrative Hearing Officer, forthwith. In view of the limited sales period each year, for suspensions affecting such sale period, a hearing shall be held at the earliest possible time that the permittee, the Administrative Hearing Officer or his designee, and the Fire Chief or his representative can schedule a meeting for such review for suspensions after the sale period. The hearing shall be held within one month after the request for hearing, which request must be made within fifteen (15) days after notice of the suspension. The Administrative Hearing Officer or his designee is authorized to set aside the suspension, or to modify the suspension by limiting its effect to only one or more days, or by setting aside the forfeiture of priority status for future years. The decision of the Administrative Hearing Officer or his/her designee shall be final.
- (u) The Calexico Fire Department will conduct an operator safety seminar for those individuals staffing the fireworks stands. Once the stand is stocked with fireworks, a member of the organization who has attended the seminar must be present during the business hours.
- (v) The Calexico Fire Department shall inspect the stand prior to its opening to the public. Periodic inspections will be conducted to ensure the safe operation of the stand.

The law does not require you to provide copies of public inspection documents that are made widely available, such as by posting them on the Internet (World Wide Web). You may be liable for a penalty of \$20 a day for each day you do not make these documents available for public inspection (up to a maximum of \$10,000 in the case of an annual return).
