

Personal Care Services

California Update: 9/22/2020

Imperial County Health Officer Order Amendment: effective 8:00 am 9/23/20

Current status as it applies to **personal services** in purple (Tier 1).

Widespread (purple):

- Tattooing, piercing, and non-medical electrolysis must close
- **Nail services and physician-ordered electrolysis may be performed indoors**
- All other services must be performed outdoors only with modifications
