Recommendation:

Discussion & Analysis:

Border Patrol will be installing a new fence along our border. The Friendship Bracelet Border mural panels will be removed. As a way of conserving a bit of history of our community, they have offered to donate some of the metal panels that have the mural painted on them. The Library, Arts, and Historical Board will be working to install the panels as pieces of art in various forms throughout our city. The plan is to organize a committee of community members and stakeholders to create the plan. Professional artists will be invited to participate on the committee to give their expert advice on how to best display the panels and/or convert them into art pieces.
